Workshop application(s) with prototype project(s) must be postmarked NO LATER THAN **APRIL 15, 2024** (for Pre-Paid Workshops). The Workshop Chair, Nancy Martin, will confirm your selection/rejection as a Pre-Paid Workshop Teacher by April 30, 2023. The prototype projects will be displayed at the Museum until the Show.
